

#### **About This Release**

Version 3.2.0 of Good Software – Cloud Suite delivers significant improvements in platform performance, user interface, and system security. This release introduces a brand-new workflow builder, smarter dashboards, and enhanced logging and compliance capabilities.

It also addresses a series of user-reported bugs and lays the groundwork for transitioning from legacy features to newer, more scalable tools. This release is fully backward-compatible with version 3.1.x.

### **Release Highlights**

This section summarizes the most impactful additions and changes in this release.

- New Custom Workflow Builder Visual editor to automate multi-step processes
- Advanced SAML 2.0 SSO Support Greater security and compliance for enterprise clients
- Performance Optimizations Faster API responses, reduced UI load time
- Critical Bug Fixes Stability improvements for all supported platforms
- Feature Sunset Notices Deprecation of legacy export and admin tools

#### **New Features**

The following features are now available in version 3.2.0. These are aimed at improving usability, automation, and customization.

| Audit Log<br>Export           | Audit data can now be exported as CSV or JSON files. Includes filtering and timestamp ranges.              | Supports compliance audits and reporting           |

Each new feature is accessible from the Admin Console or under your organization's configuration settings. Documentation and usage examples are available in the User Guide.



### **Enhancements**

This release improves existing functionality across the platform, particularly in terms of performance, UI consistency, and security.

| Component   | Improvement  |
|-------------|--|
| REST API v2 | Reduced average response time by 40%. Pagination added to bulk endpoints.                            |
| UI/UX       | Consistent font usage, tighter layout spacing, and accessibility improvements (WCAG 2.1 compliance). |
| Security    | OAuth 2.0 token expiration is now configurable. SAML sessions auto-terminate after inactivity.       |

Performance improvements will be most noticeable in data-heavy modules like reporting, API integrations, and logs.

## **Bug Fixes**

This section lists key issues resolved in this release. All fixes have been tested against supported environments.

| ID    | Issue Summary  | Status   |
|-------|--|----------|
| #2348 | Safari browser failed to initiate SSO login            | Resolved |
| #2211 | PDF export included broken footer links                | Resolved |
| #2123 | Firefox users could not click the workflow save button | Resolved |
| #2098 | Reports with over 1000 rows timed out                  | Resolved |

## **Deprecated Features**

The following features are scheduled for deprecation and will be fully removed in upcoming releases. Users should begin planning migration strategies now.



| Feature         | Feature    | Notes  |
|-----------------|------------|--|
| CSV Export Tool | Deprecated | Use JSON Export API going forward            |
| Legacy Admin UI | Deprecated | Hidden by default, will be removed in v3.4.0 |

#### **Known Issues**

The following known issues exist in this release. Fixes are planned for version 3.2.1 unless otherwise noted.

| Issue                    | Description  | Workaround                                 |
|--------------------------|--|--|
| Dashboard load delay     | Dashboards may take longer to load on iOS Safari       | Use Chrome or Firefox on mobile            |
| LDAP sync logging issue  | Some sync logs do not appear in the admin panel        | Logs are intact and accessible via<br>API  |
| Inline editing conflicts | In rare cases, concurrent edits may not save correctly | Avoid simultaneous edits in shared records |

## **System Requirements**

Ensure your system meets the following requirements before upgrading:

#### **Browsers Supported:**

- Google Chrome (latest)
- Firefox ESR
- Microsoft Edge 109+
- Safari 14+

#### **Server Requirements:**

- OS: Ubuntu 22.04, RHEL 9, Windows Server 2019
- Database: PostgreSQL 13+, MySQL 8
- RAM: Minimum 8GB (16GB recommended)



• Java Runtime: Java 17+

## **Upgrade Instructions**

Follow the steps below to upgrade your instance to version 3.2.0:


- 1. **Backup your environment** Ensure both the database and filesystem are backed up.
- 2. **Review deprecated features** Transition from deprecated tools like the CSV exporter.
- 3. Run the Installer Use the Upgrade Package from the admin panel.
- 4. **Post-upgrade checks** Run system diagnostics from the Admin Console > Health Check.

Downtime is expected to be under 10 minutes for standard installations.
