Use the equipment inventory to ensure you have all your gear in your next mission. With item subtypes, you can include all information needed for each item that should be present at boarding time.

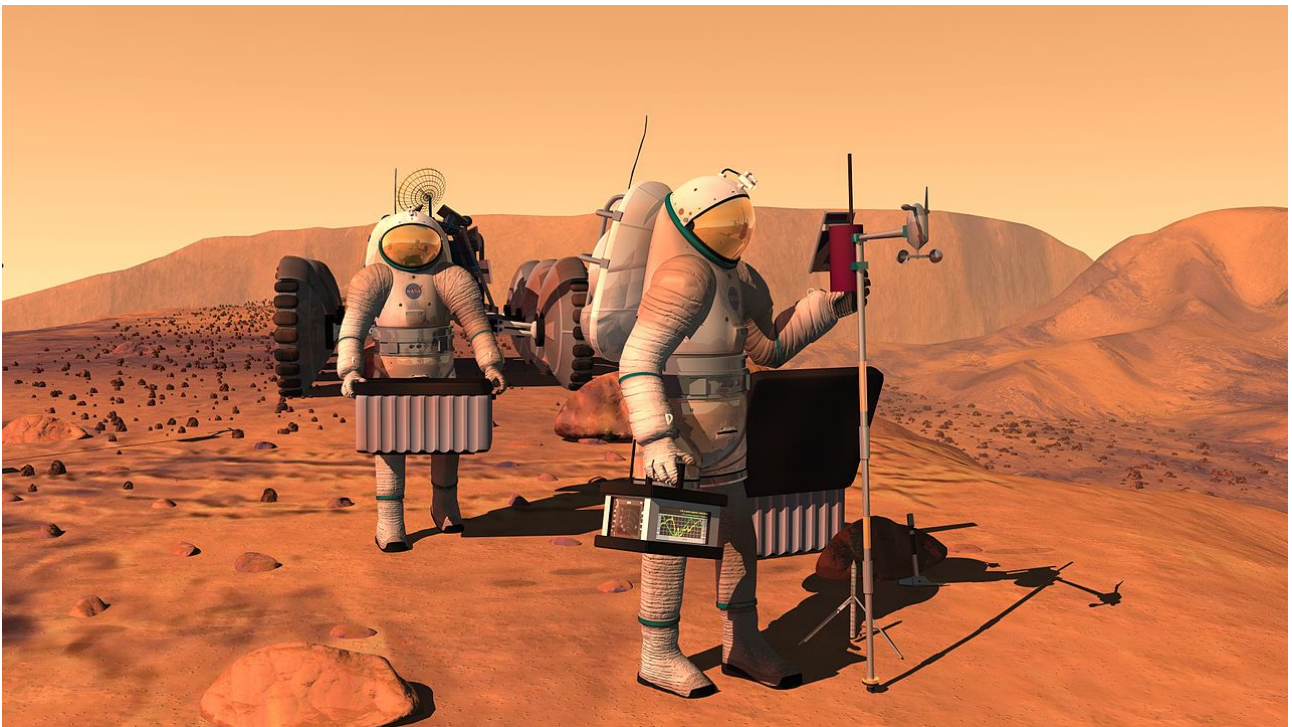
1 How Equipment Inventory Works

As you prepare for your next launch, you can use the equipment inventory to ensure all gear is in place and accounted for. For each item in the launch inventory, there are subtypes which you can use to include additional information.

Here are a few of the included subtypes:

- Thrusters
- Jetpacks
- Rocket Cleaner
- Moon Boots
- Rovers

2 Load Balancing

As you add equipment to your inventory, SeeSpaceEZ works in the background to analyze the weight and size of all items to find the best compartment in which to store each. You can see the recommended placement of gear in the Compartment List. You can also manually set the compartment an item is stored in and the load will be rebalanced accordingly.

3 Sharing the Equipment List

When you are ready to load your rocket, you can share the list of equipment with your team. When sharing, you can assign team members to certain equipment, or to specific storage compartments to help with an efficient loading process. Click **Share** on the equipment inventory to beginning sharing the list.
